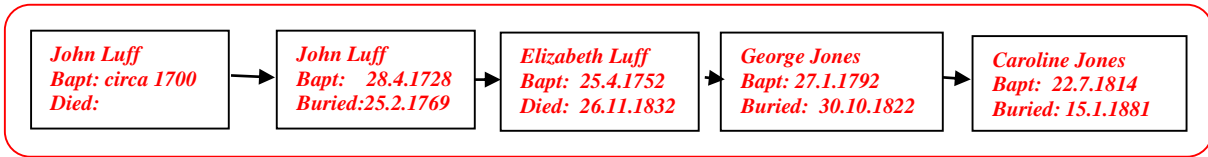


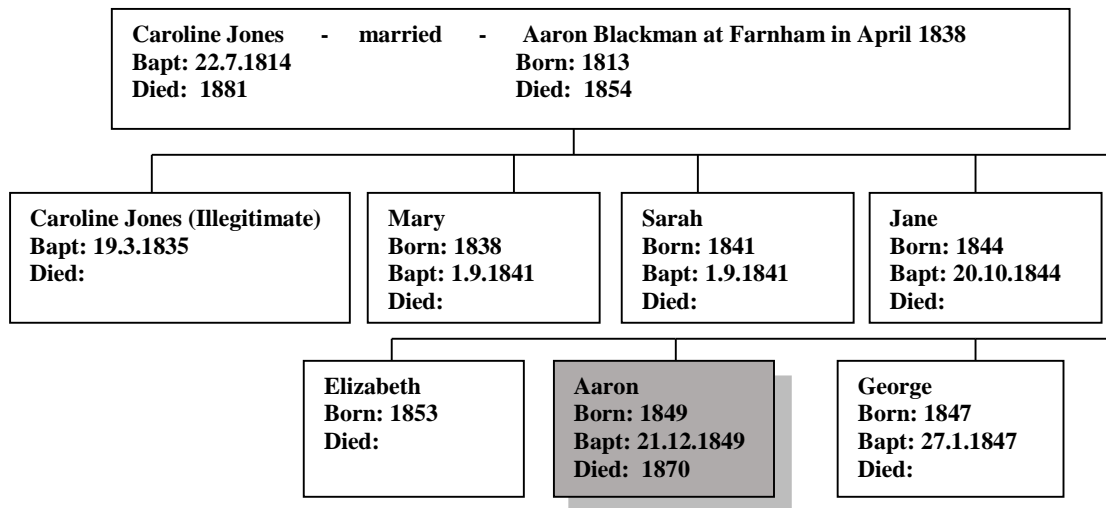
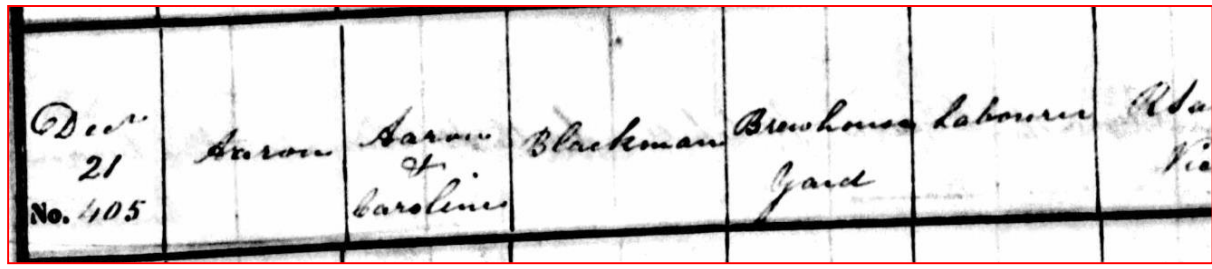
**Aaron Blackman 1849 - 1870**
