

Family Lineage:



Their first child was William Samuel James born in 1919. He died shortly afterwards accidentally smothered by his mother. Due to the nature of the death Annie had was summoned to appear before Henry Robert Oswald, H.M Coroner for the City of London, on 5th November 1919, to give evidence about the death.

Lucy Beatrice their third child was born on 9th February 1928.

Annie and William lived at 33, Stadium Street until they were bombed out during the Blitz in 1940. They were re-housed in Draycott Avenue but again they were bombed out.

They were finally re-housed at 34 Hortensia House, Chelsea in 1942.

They lived there until Annie's husband William died in Chelsea on 29th May 1957.

In 1959 Annie moved to 12, Jean Darling House, Chelsea. She remained there until moving out to Haverhill, Suffolk, following the tragic accidental death of her son-in-law Frederick William Illsley in 1961. Her daughter Lucy Beatrice Luff had 4 children at the time of her husband's untimely death. Annie moved to Haverhill with her daughter and 4 grandchildren.

Annie died in Haverhill, Suffolk on 3rd September 1981, she died following a head injury. (Source: Official Death certificate)
