


Family Lineage:




Alfred Luff was born in Northaw circa 1867. He is the son of James and Hannah Luff.



The 1871 Census shows Alfred, aged 4, living with his father, a widower, and his two siblings Selina and Charles. The family were living at Bridgefoot Farm, South Mimms, where his father was employed as a coachman. Also living with the family was a relative Henry Luff, born in Farnham, aged 21 and also employed as a groom.

The 1881 Census shows Alfred, now aged 16, living with his father, James who had now remarried. His new wife was called Susan, and they were married between 1871 and 1880. They were still living at Bridgeford Farm. Also living in the family house was a child called William, aged 9 years old, presumably a child of the new marriage.

At the time of the 1901 census the family were living in Wakefield, Yorkshire. Alfred was still employed as a coachman/groom. Their son Alfred was then 6 years old.



Alfred himself died on 29th March, 1930 ay Hayes, Middlesex, Extract from the Will/Probate for Alfred Ernest Luff.
