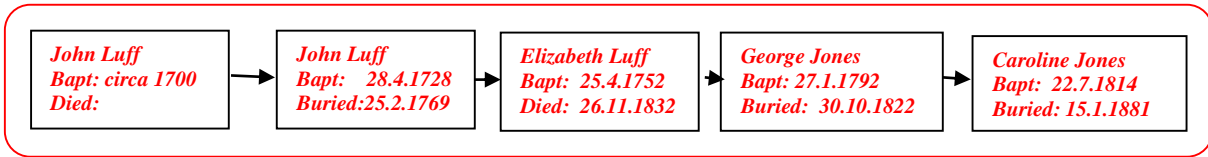


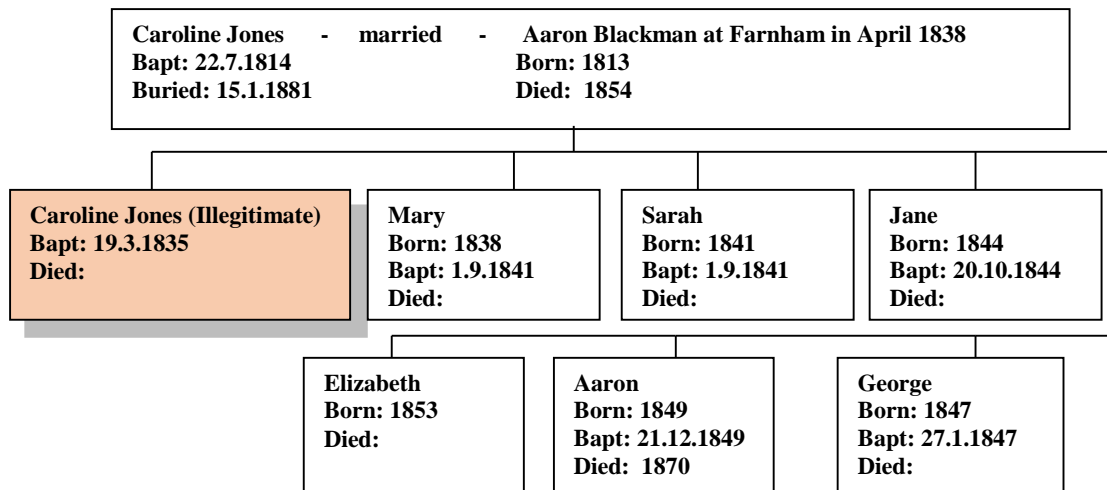
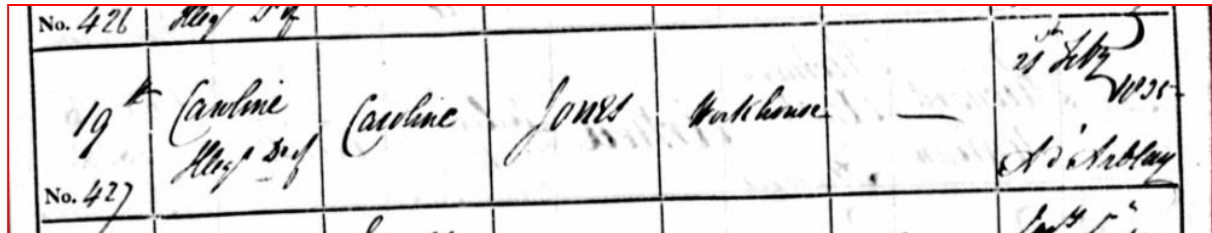
**Caroline Blackman (Baptised Jones) 1835 -**
