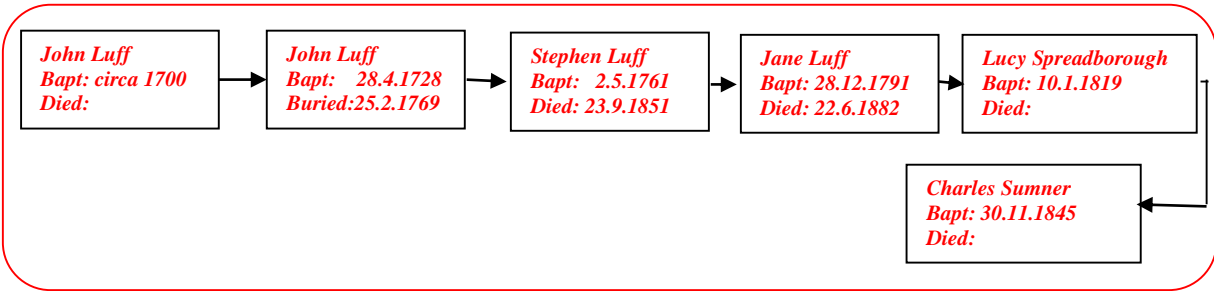

Charles Sumner was baptised in Plumstead, Kent on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 1870. He was the son of Charles and Mary Ann Sumner.

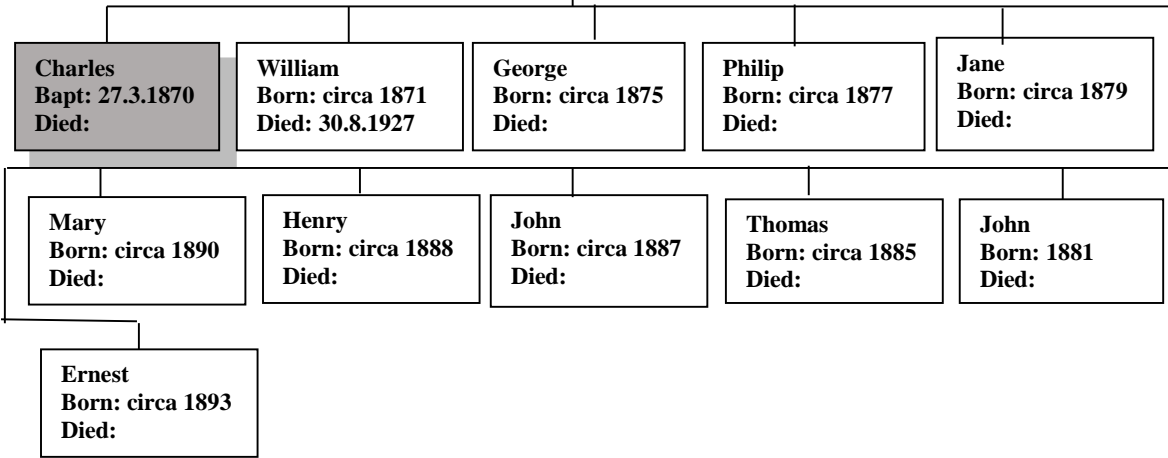

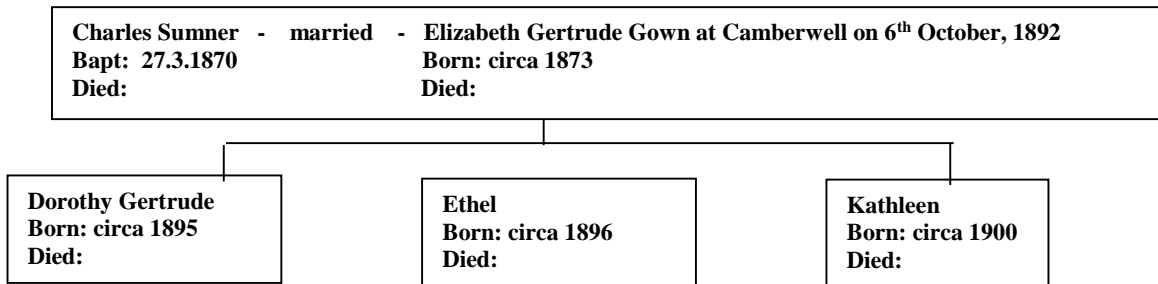
