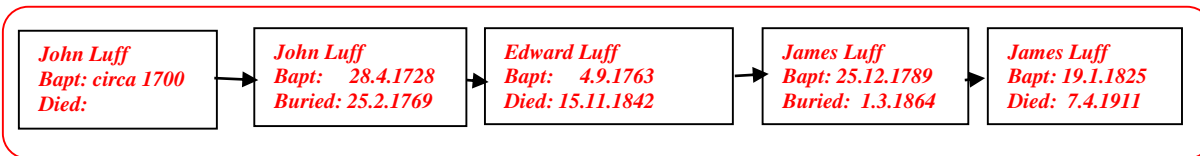

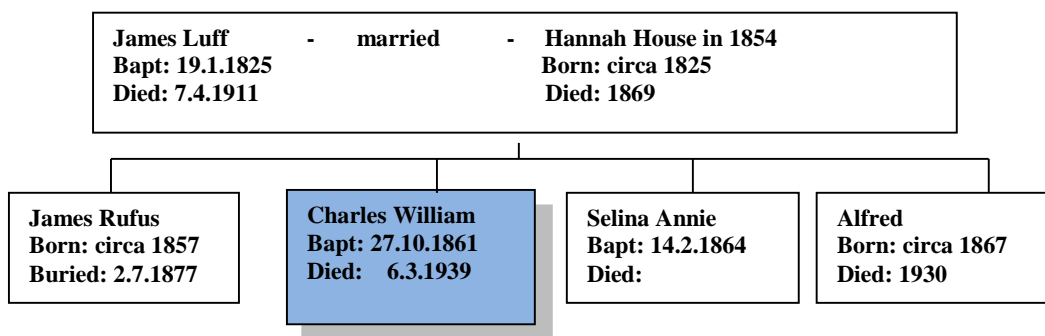
Charles William Luff was baptized in Allhallows Church, Tottenham, Middlesex on 27th October, 1861. He is the son of James and Hannah Luff.

The 1871 Census shows Charles, aged 9, living with his father and siblings Selina and Alfred at The Lodge, Bridgefoot Farm, South Mimms. Also living with the family was a relative Henry Luff, born in Farnham, aged 21 and employed as a groom. (Henry was the 2nd Cousin to Charles William).

The 1881 Census shows Charles, now aged 19 and single, living at Wilby Mews, Kensington. He was employed as a Groom.

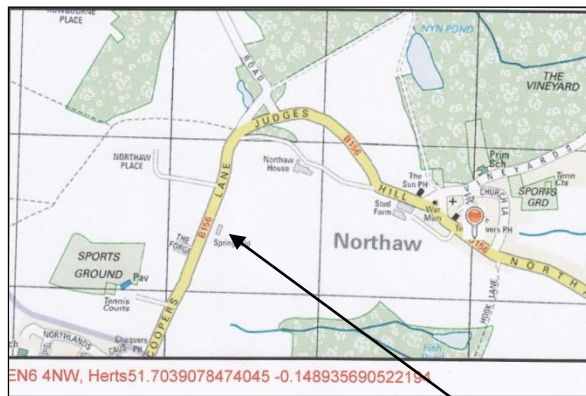

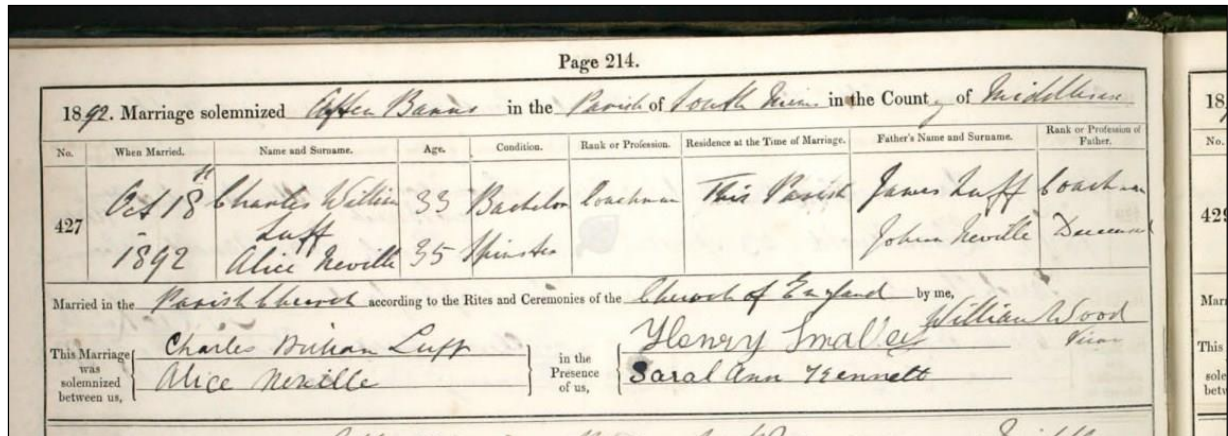
