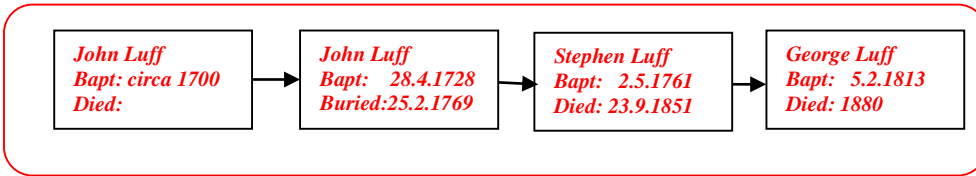


Emma Luff 1849 - 1906

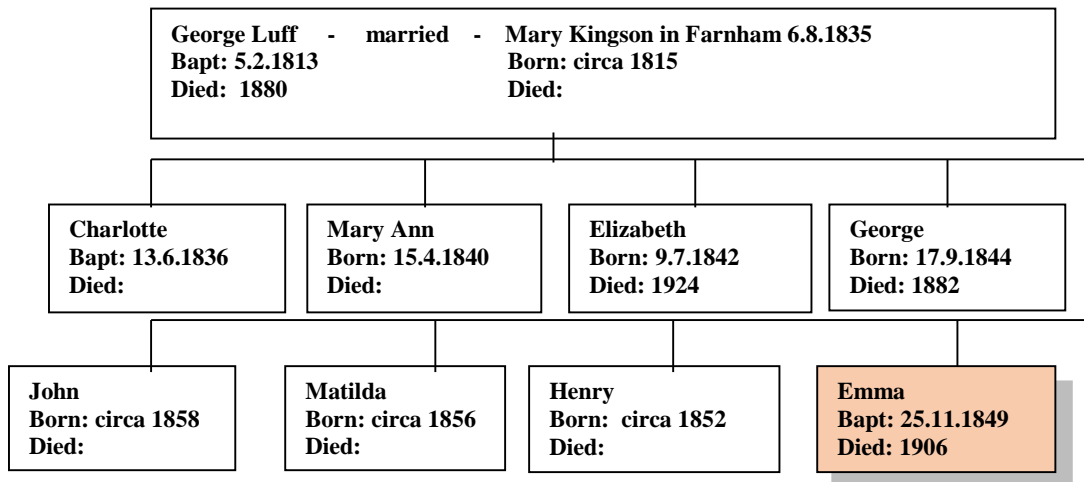
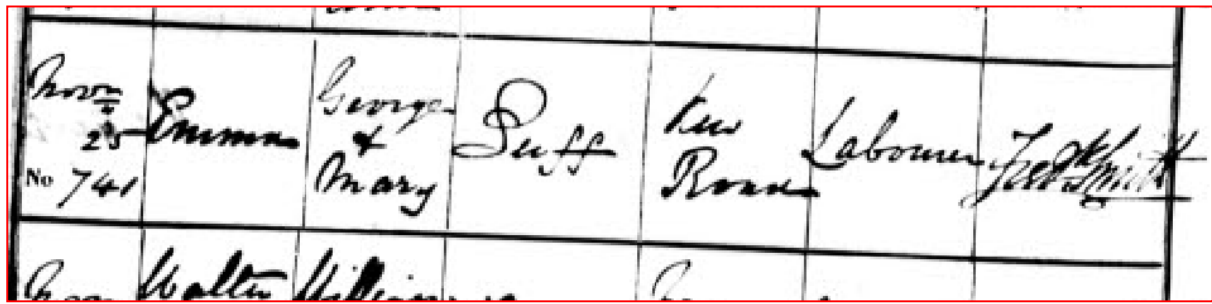
