
George Frederick Luff 1875 - 1955

George Frederick Luff was born in Hale in 1875. He was a son of James and Lucy Luff.



In the 1881 census George Frederick was 6 years old and living with her parents at Providence Cottages, Upper Hale.

George was a bricklayer by trade, and he lived with his parents at Providence Cottages, Upper Hale until his father died in 1883. He then lived with his mother and older brother Frederick at Box Cottages, Upper Hale.



In the 1901 census George was living with his mother, Lucy, then aged 67, at Wyke Cottages, Hale. George was employed as a carpenters labourer. Living with them were George's brother James and his son William Charles. George remained in the household as he was the only 'breadwinner'.

On 13th November 1903, George's mother died. George then married Adeline Smith at the Farnham Registry Office on 21st December 1903. The couple were living at 3, Box Cottages, Upper Hale.



The 1911 census states that George & Adeline had had 7 children, 6 of whom were living. The family were living at 65a Ulverdale Road, Chelsea. George lists his occupation as a Power Worker at the Lots Road Power Station. However they eventually had 10 children, 9 of whom lived to adulthood.

George Frederick Luff died at 11, Hillside Lane, Heath End, Farnham on 20th September, 1955. He died from Hypostatic Congestion (poor blood circulation) and Senile Myocarditis. His son William was present at his death.

This photo is of George Luff and his wife Adeline. In 1911 George Luff was living with his family at 65a Ulverdale Road, Chelsea. He was employed in the Lots Road Power Station which was opened in 1905 in Chelsea Creek. He later moved to Flood Street, Chelsea.

In 1945 George & his wife Adeline were living at 11 Hillside Cottages, Heath End. George was present at the death of his elder sister Jane (Ayling) in Farnham in 1945. Looking at the age of the couple this picture could be taken at Heath End.
