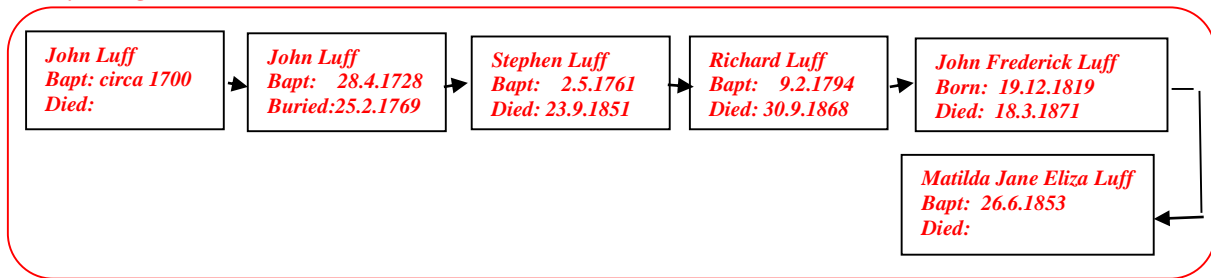


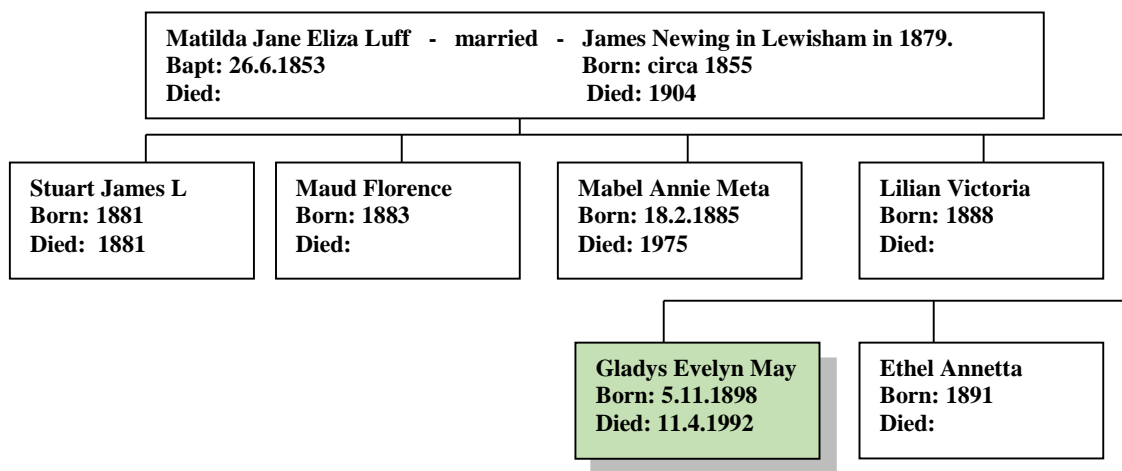

On 14<sup>th</sup> May, 1910 Gladys and her mother Matilda emigrated to Philadelphia, United States. Her mother Matilda now a widow was aged 57 and Gladys aged 11. They resided at 57 Wayne Lane, Wilkes Barre, Philadelphia. The ships manifest is a little confusing as it states Matilda was living, prior to emigration, with her brother in St Helens (presumably Lancashire), and in consequent Gladys' uncle. I'm pretty certain that it is Matilda and Gladys as the ages are correct, as is the full Christian names, i.e. Marilda J E, and Gladys E M.
