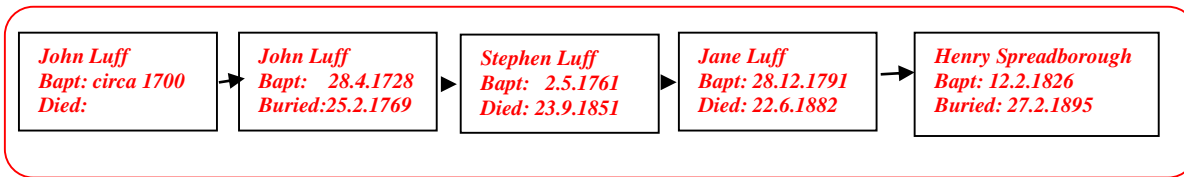

The Electoral Registers from 1922 to 1929 show Henry and Fanny Spreadborough living at 111, Risley Avenue, Tottenham.

Fanny Elizabeth Spreadborough died in Edmonton, Middlesex in December, 1929.

I am unable to confirm the death of Henry Spreadborough. There is evidence that Henry might have remarried again, this time to Elizabeth Brant, in 1930, in Warminster, Wiltshire.
