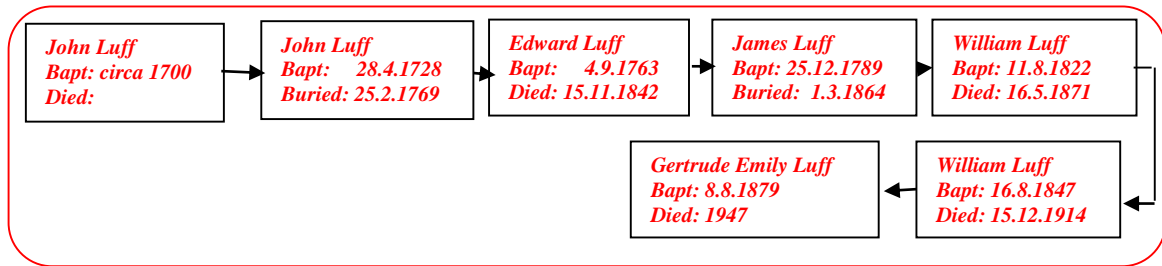


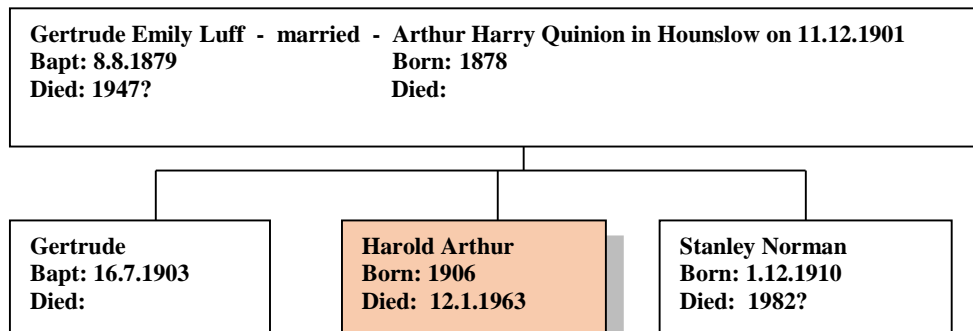
Harold Arthur Quinion 1906 - 1963

In the Electoral Register for 1929 Harold Arthur Quinion was living with his mother Gertrude Quinion at 17, Fulham Road, W.14.

Harold Arthur Quinion married Olive M Herbert in Kensington in 1931.

The Electoral Register for 1932 shows that Harold and his new wife Olive were living with Harold's mother, Gertrude Quinion at 17, Fulham Road, W.14.

The Electoral Register for 1935 show that Harold & olive were living at 83, Orchard Gate, Greenford, North London.

In 1936 the Register shows them as moved to 9, Charleville Road, Fulham, W.14.

In 1939 the family were still living at 9, Charleville Road, also living with them was Harold's mother Gertrude and his younger brother Stanley Norman.

Harold Arthur Quinion died on 12th January, 1963, at Harefield Hospital, Middlesex.
