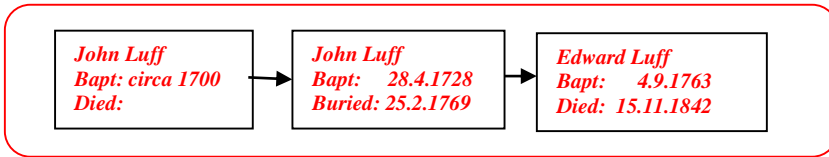


**James Luff 1789 - 1864**

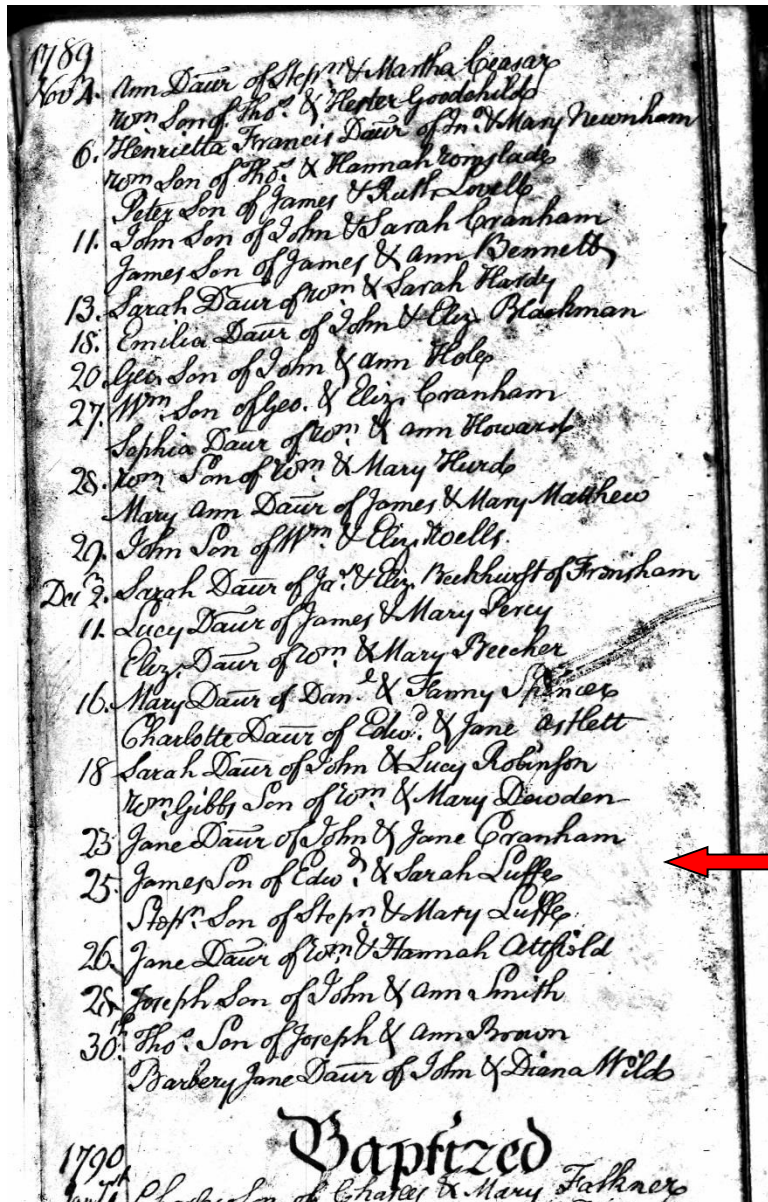

**Family Lineage:**

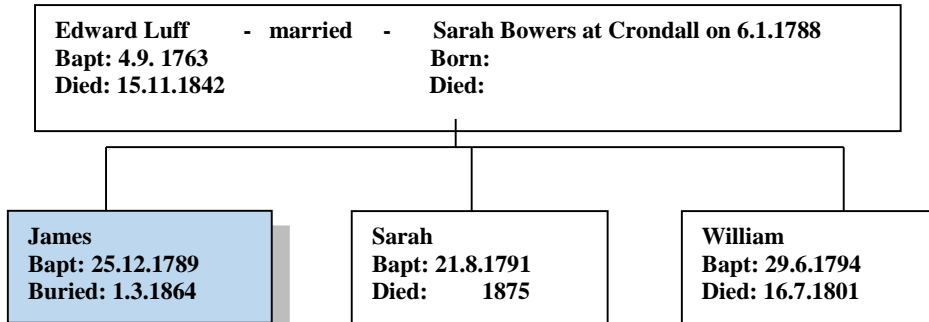

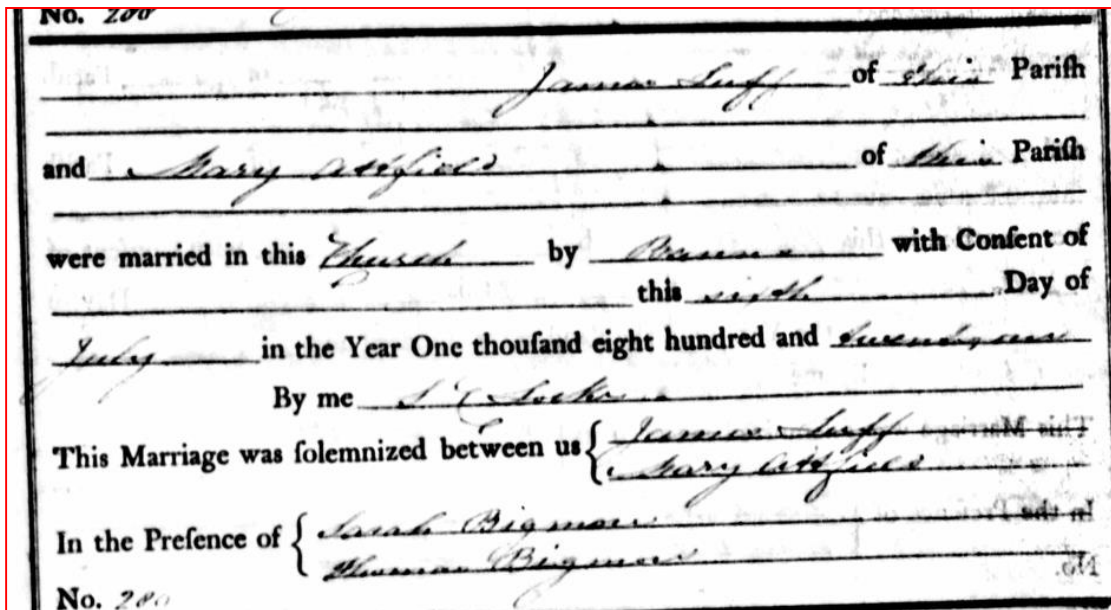
Extract from the Baptism records of St Andrew's Church 1789.



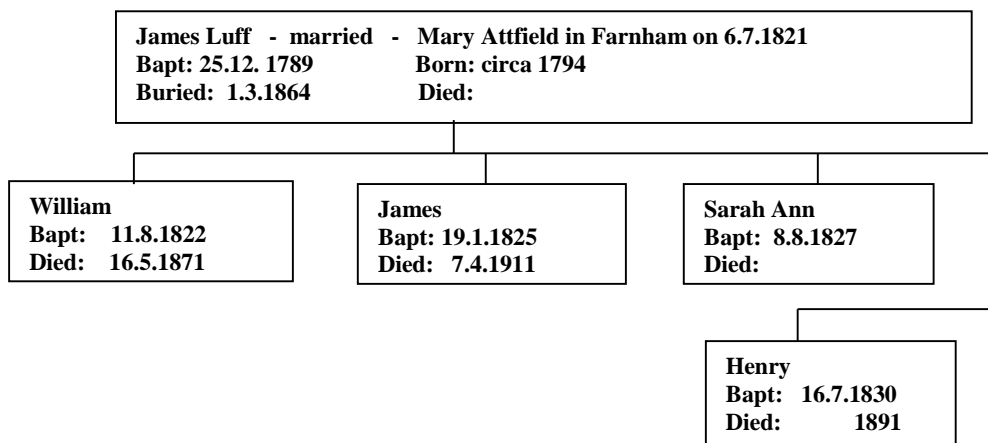

Records show that James married Mary Attfield in Farnham on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 1821.

On the 1841 Census James puts his age as 45 and employed as a cordwainer. The family were living in Abbey Street, Farnham.

A cordwainer was someone who worked with Cordovan, a soft leather from Spain, to make shoes. A cordwainer (or cordovan) is someone who makes shoes and other articles from fine soft leather.
