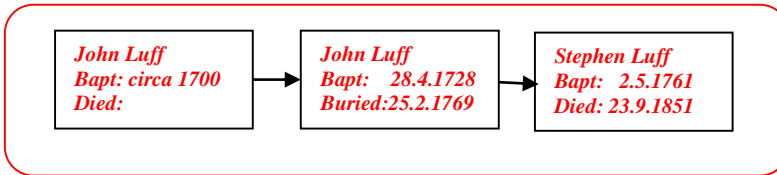


Jane Luff 1791 - 1882

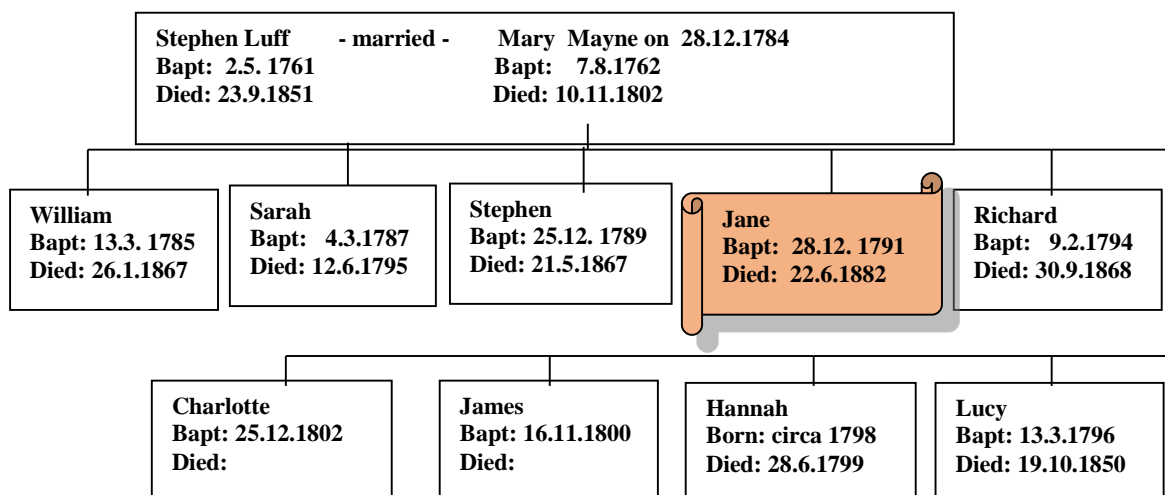
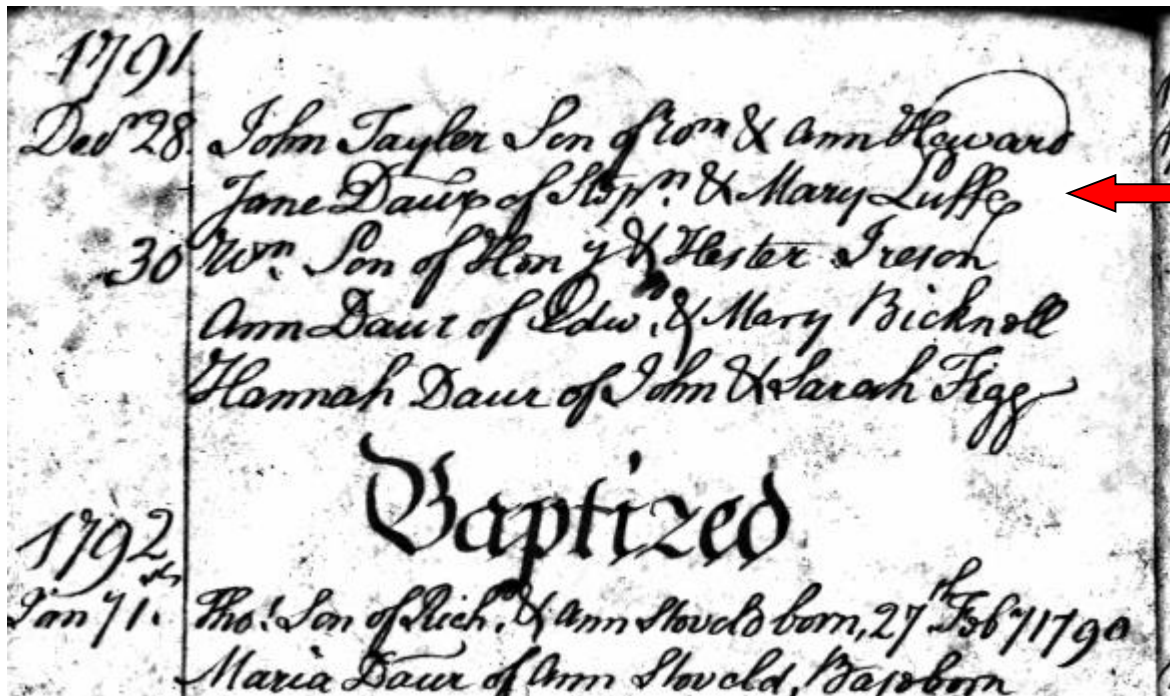

Jane Luff was baptised at St Andrew's Church, Farnham on 28th December, 1791. She is the daughter of Stephen and Mary Luff. Her Death Certificate in 1882 suggests she was born in 1787.

Jane Luff married John Spreadborough in Farnham on 15th July, 1815. John Spreadborough was a tailor by trade. Jane's brother, Stephen Luff, was a witness to the wedding. It is interesting that Stephen could write his own name but, apparently not Jane.

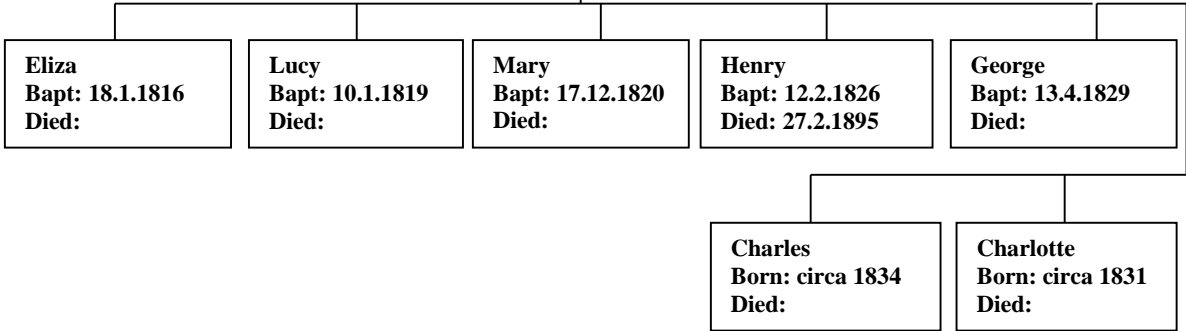

Jane Spread (Spreadborough) died on 22nd June, 1882 at Shackleford, Woking. Jane was recorded as 95 years old when she died, making her birth 1787. I have a record of her baptism as 28.12.1791. Jane died of Senile Decay, probably just old age. Elizabeth Spread, her daughter, was present at her death. (Source: Official Death Certificate)

Jane Spread (Spreadborough) died and was buried in Woking on 27th June, 1882. She was 95 years old.
