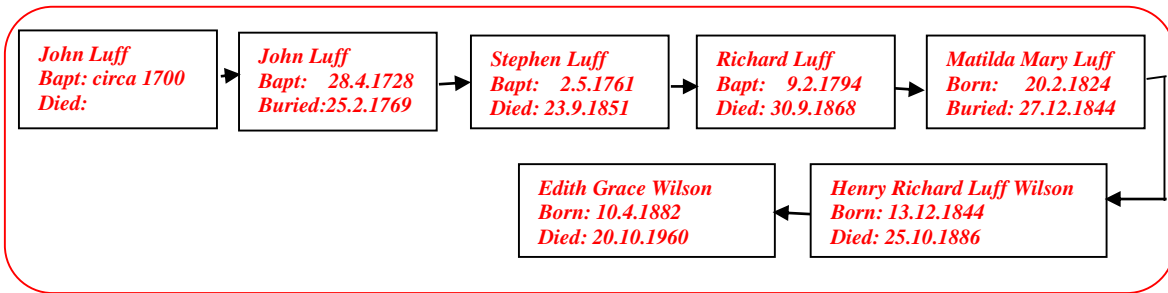


Marjorie Grace Corinna Ross 1903 - 1989

Extract from the Baptism records of St Marks, Battersea, Surrey, showing the baptism of Marjorie Grace Ross on 18th December, 1904.

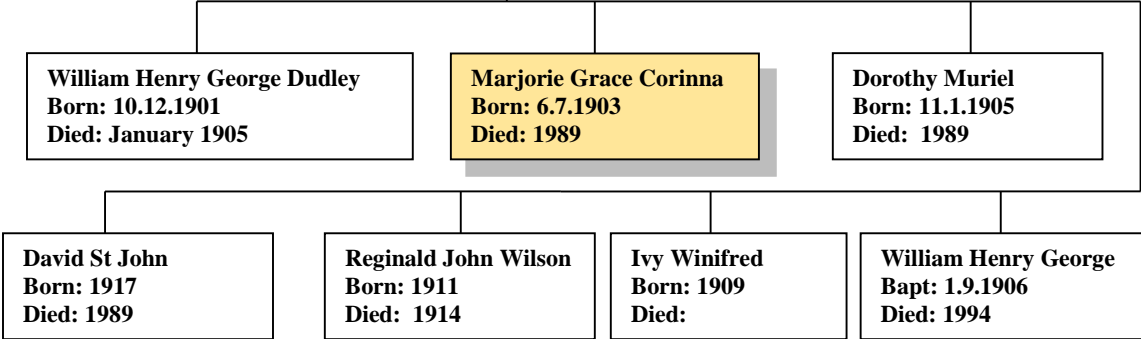

In 1918 Marjorie moved with her family to 31, St Johns Hill Grove, Battersea. This was the family home until 1960 when her mother, Edith, died. Her father lived at this address until his death in 1969.

Marjorie never married and the Electoral Register for 1930 shows that she was living at 31, St Johns Hill Grove, and entitled to vote, along with her sister Ivy, both single, and her brother William Henry George. Both Marjorie and Ivy, remained unmarried, and continued to live with their parents at 31 St Johns Hill Grove until their deaths.
