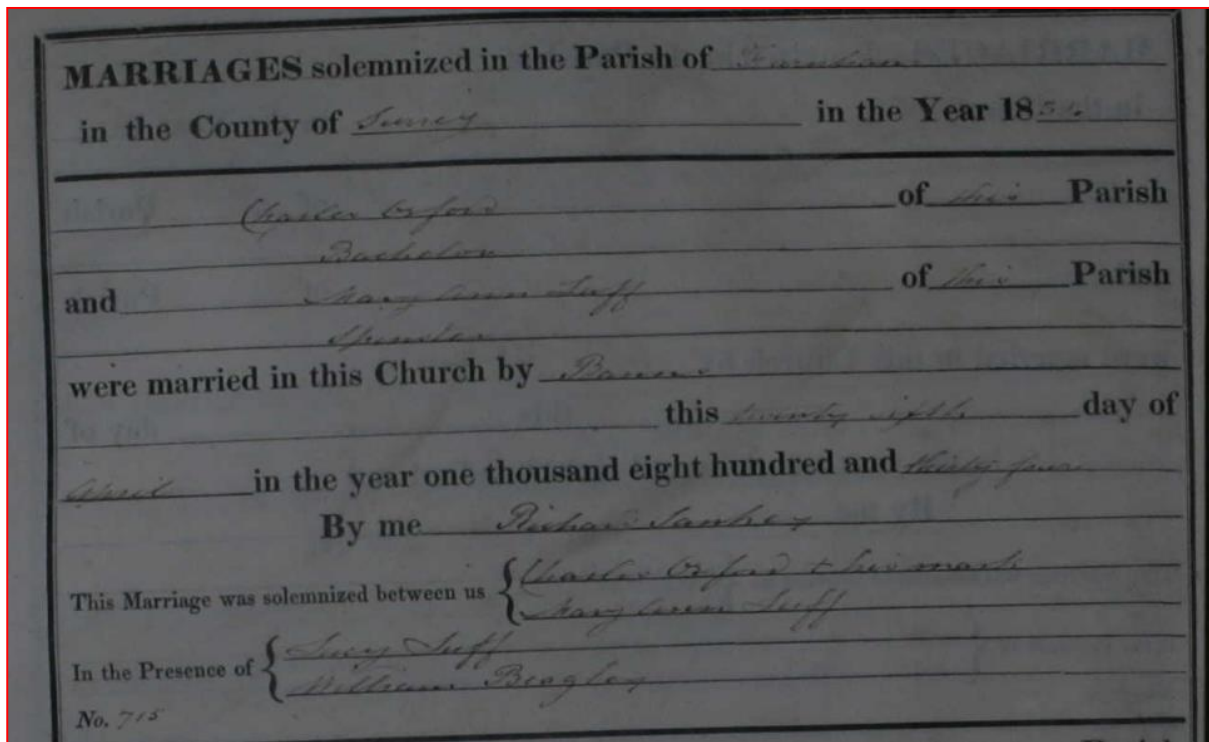
Mary Ann Luff was baptised in Farnham on 13<sup>th</sup> August 1811. She was the daughter of William and Jane Luff.



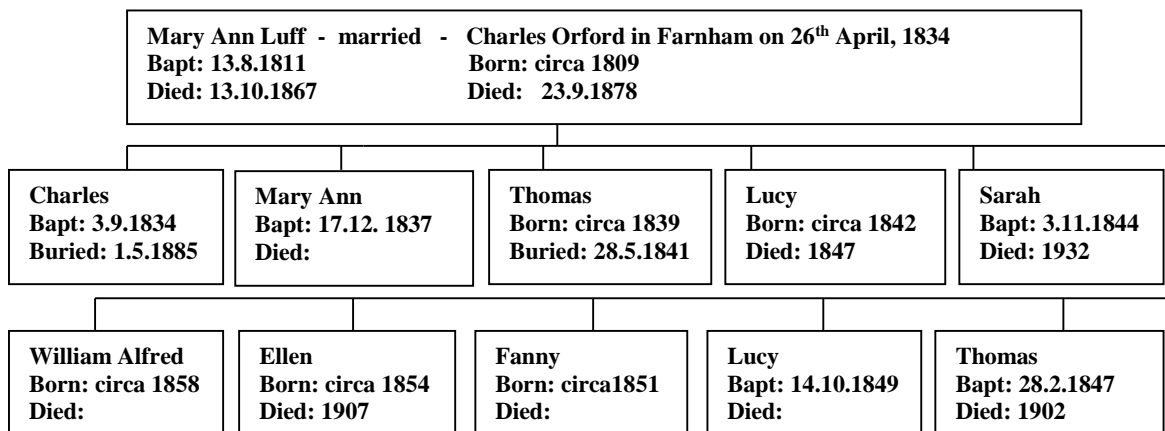
