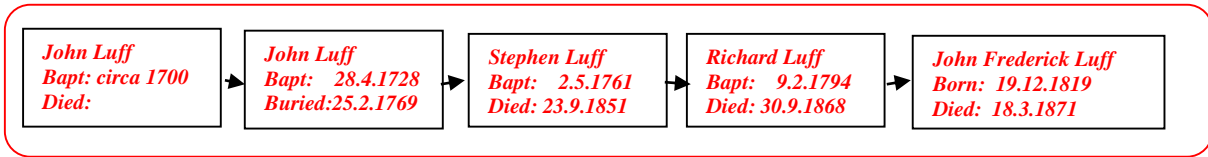


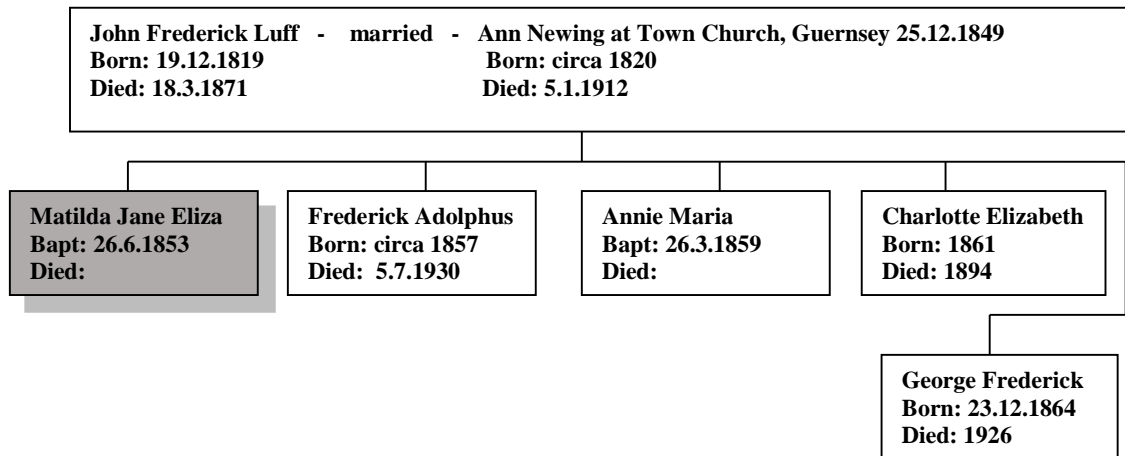

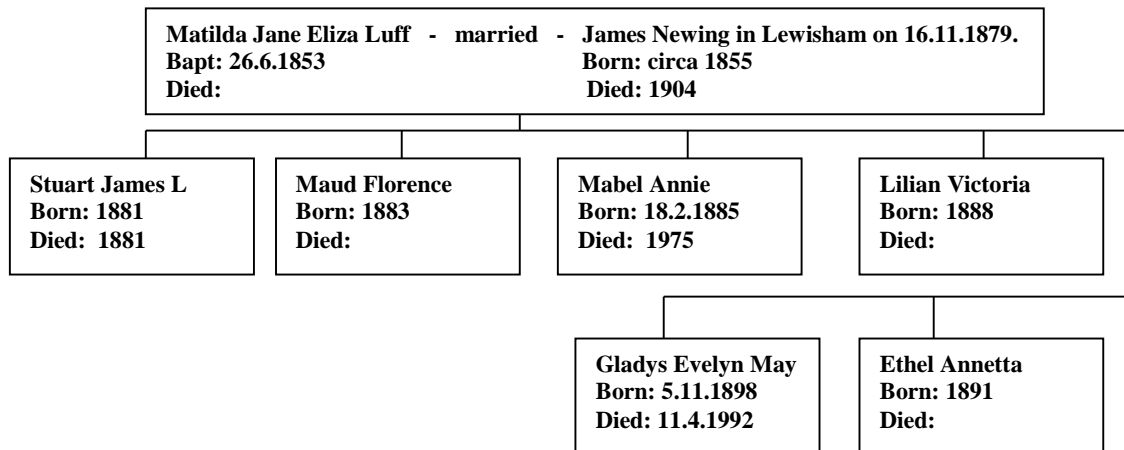
Matilda's father, John Frederick Luff, died on 18th March, 1871.

Matilda's husband James died in Elham in 1904.

On 14th May, 1910 Matilda and her daughter Gladys emigrated to Philadelphia, United States. Matilda now a widow was aged 57 and Gladys aged 11. Their residence in the U.S.A. was 57 Wayne Lane, Wilkes Barre, Philadelphia. The ships manifest states that, prior to emigration, Matilda and Gladys were living with her brother George and his family in St Helens, Lancashire.
