

Robert Luff was baptised at St Andrew's Church, Farnham, on 13th March 1825.

In the 1841 and 1851 censuses he was living with his parents, Stephen and Sarah, in Aldershot. The 1851 census shows him unmarried, 27 years of age and employed as an agricultural labourer.

In 1861 the census shows that he was living in Weybourne, near Farnham. It seems he was sharing accommodation at the Soldiers Return public house, which was run by his brother Charles. He was employed as a labourer.

In the census of 1871 Robert was living with his brother Charles in No Wives Lane, Hale. He was still employed as a labourer and still unmarried.

Robert died in 1876.
