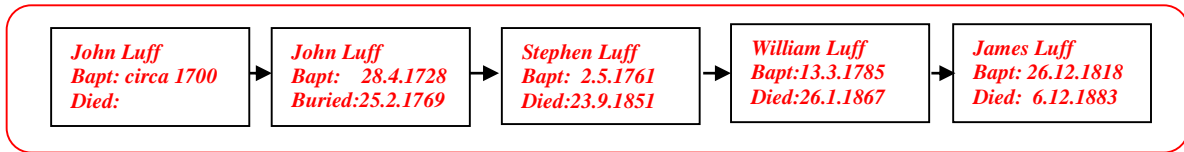


**William James Luff 1856 - 1922**

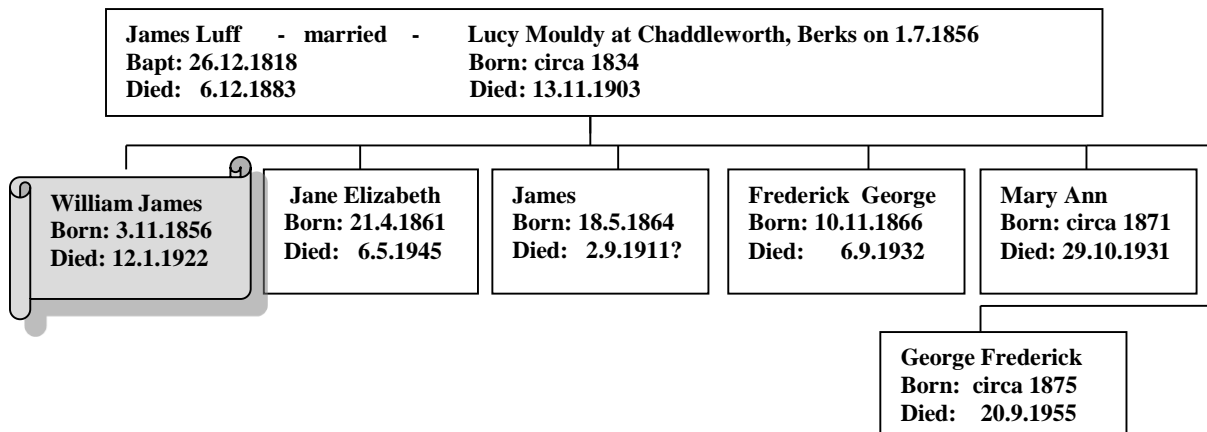

William James was born in Hungry Hill, Hale, Farnham on 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 1856. He was the son of James and Lucy Luff. (Source: Official Birth certificate).

Future records suggest that William James was illiterate, and possibly backward.

The 1881 Census shows William, now aged 24 and single, lodging with Thomas Anwell and his family at Alma Road, Enfield. William was a bricklayer. The census also states that William is classified as 'senseless', but that could have meant backward.

The 1911 Census shows William and Kate (Catherine) living at 32 Prebend Street, Camden, North London. The Census show that they have been married for 22 years, having had 2 children, only 1 surviving. I have been unable to establish the names of the children. This document is confusing as William seems to have completed and signed it. William states his birth place as being Clerkenwell, London which completely contradicts the statement on the 1901 Census. I find it difficult to believe that William would be capable of completing this document unaided.
