
Family Lineage:

The 1911 Census shows William and Kate (Catherine) living at 32 Prebend Street, Camden, North London. The Census show that they have been married for 22 years, having had 2 children, only 1 surviving. I have been unable to establish the names of the children. This document is confusing as William seems to have completed and signed it. William states his birth place as being Clerkenwell, London which completely contradicts the statement on the 1901 Census. I find it difficult to believe that William would be capable of completing this document unaided.



William James Luff died in the St Pancras South Infirmary on 12^{th} January, 1922, he was 65 years old. He was admitted on 6^{th} January and died of Bronchitis. His wife Kate was the informant, and they were residing at 29 Prebend Street, St Pancras.
