




William was baptised in St Michael's Church, Aldershot on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 1785. He was the son of Stephen and Mary Luff.




William Luff married Jane Gadd who was born in Hale circa 1785. The couple were married at St John's Church, Hale on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 1806. Neither William nor Jane made their 'mark' on the parish records, which suggests they could understand the written word. Witnesses to the marriage were Sarah Franks and John Bradley.




The marriage produced the following recorded children:



The 1841 Censuses show that William was living in an abode in Hungry Hill, Upper Hale, and was employed as a Sawyer. His wife Jane was in the house with children James and Mary.

There is a reference to Mary Luff, aged 10, living with William and Jane. I am unable to confirm that Mary is the child of William and Jane. Continued...... Hungry Hill today (2010) where William Luff was employed as a sawyer.



The 1851 Census shows William, now aged 65, living with his wife in Hungry Hill, Hale, Farnham. William was still employed as a sawyer.

Jane was buried at St John's Church, Hale on 18th March, 1865.


Extract from a publication 'Andrew Windsor's Almshouses', written by Pat Heather ©2008. "William Luff was offered a vacant almshouse by the Trustees when they met on the 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1866," *if he was in a fit state to be moved*". He entered the almshouse at the beginning of October but died within four months."

William died in the Almshouses, in Castle Street, Farnham, on 26th January 1867. Mary Ann (Orford), William's daughter was present at his death. William died of pneumonia aged 83. (Source: Official Death certificate)
