

John Luff(e) was probably born around 1520. I know this because he and his wife Maude had their son John baptised at St Andrews Church, Farnham, Surrey on 18th January, 1844.



→ Time Line

(1538) After the split Rome. Thomas Cromwell ordered that each parish priest must keep a book, and that the Parson, in the presence of the wardens, must enter all the baptisms, marriages and burials.

Extract from St Andrews Church baptism records for 1544. The writing seems to show the Latin filius for 'son', but the scribe seems to use the English word daughter for a female.
