
Mary Ann Luff 1871 - 1931

Mary Ann was born in Farnham in 1871. She was a daughter of James and Lucy Luff.



In the 1881 census Mary Ann was 10 years old and living with her parents at Providence Cottages, Upper Hale.

The 1891 census shows Mary Ann working as a servant at the 5th Dragoons barracks in Aldershot.


It seems likely that she met her future husband there, Samuel John Payne Thomas, as he was a soldier based in Aldershot.

Mary Ann married Samuel John Payne Thomas on 31.5.1894, at Aldershot. They were married at the Wesleyan Methodist Church in Grosvenor Road, Aldershot.

On 12th September 1894 Samuel was posted to India and it seems likely Mary went with him. Mary and Samuel had 6 children, 4 in India, 1 in South Africa and 1 in Chelsea when Samuel discharged himself from the army 16th January 1908.


On their return from India the family lived at 33, Stadium Street, Chelsea, London.

After seeing service in the 1^{st} World War he was appointed Park Keeper at the Royal Park at Bushey, later St James' Park and finally Richmond Park.

Mary Ann Thomas (nee Luff) with husband Samuel John Payne Thomas. Mary Ann Luff was William Charles Luff's aunt and mother of Annie Beatrice.



Mary died on 29 October 1931, at St Georges Hospital, London she was 60 years old.

Mary died from fatty myocarditis (inflammation of the heart muscles), and ascitis (enlarged liver and spleen). Her son William James was in attendance when she died. Mary was buried in Brompton Cemetery.
