
## Rosina Woolley 1860 -


This is a history of Rosina Woolley (1860 - ) and her family.

Rosina Woolley was born in Aldershot circa 1860. She was the daughter of Harriett and William Woolley.



Rosina Woolley married William Charles Hawkins in September, 1882. They had 3 children.



In 1891 Rosina and her husband William were living in Richmond Road, Mortlake. William was aged 30, employed as a coachman/groom and gives his birth place as Hounslow in Middlesex. Rosina was aged 30. They have 2 daughters, Edith aged 4 and Gertrude aged. The children were born in Whitwick, Leicestershire.

In the 1901 census the family had moved and were living at 2 Rayment Cottage, Isleworth, Brentford. William was now employed as a streetlighter. Living with them were Gertrude their daughter now aged 12, and another daughter Dorothy aged 1.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 132 St Johns Road, Isleworth. William was then aged 50 and employed as a lamplighter for the Brentford Gas Co.

Rosina was aged 50 and confirms she had been married to her husband for 28 years. She had had 4 children, 3 of whom were still living. Their daughter Dorothy died in 1901.

Their daughter Edith was now living with them, she was single, aged 24 and self employed as a dressmaker. Gertrude their younger daughter was single, aged 22 and employed as a drapers assistant. William and Rosina had a fourth child. William E was born in 1903. He was now aged 8 and was born in Isleworth.
