




Other Grose family historians suggest William Pellow Harvey married Elizabeth Hitchens in June 1889 in Redruth Cornwall. I have been unable to confirm this fact. Their first child, Claughton, had his birth registered in June 1890 in Redruth. It seems after 1890 the family emigrated to Canada.
